LunaJets

FLYING ON EMPTY LEG FLIGHTS AT DISCOUNT PRICES

Every day, hundreds of business jets fly around the world "empty", when returning home after dropping off a client. Founded this summer, the Geneva-based Lunajets launched a new and unprecedented internet-based concept, selling these empty leg flights at substantially reduced prices. These are 50 to 80 percent of full private jet fares and are based on flight time, independently of the aircraft flown. Individual seats can be purchased on flights shorter than 2h3omin, while the whole cabin (12 to 14 passengers) must be purchased on long haul flights. A JetShare forum will be soon available on the lunajets.com, and will allow different parties to share flights on the same journey. More than 75 operators are already taking part in the program and Lunajets now has around 1,000 members.
